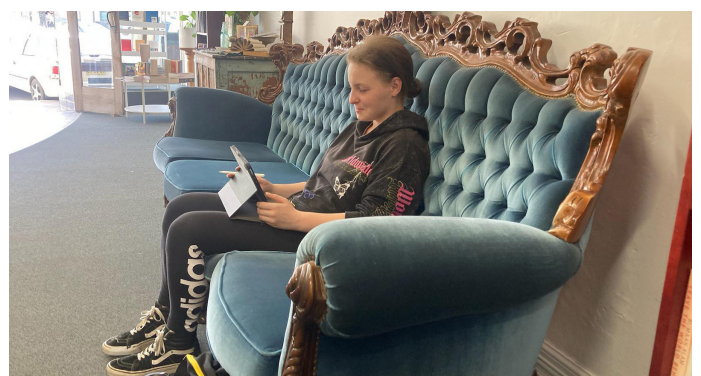
### Accelerated Reader

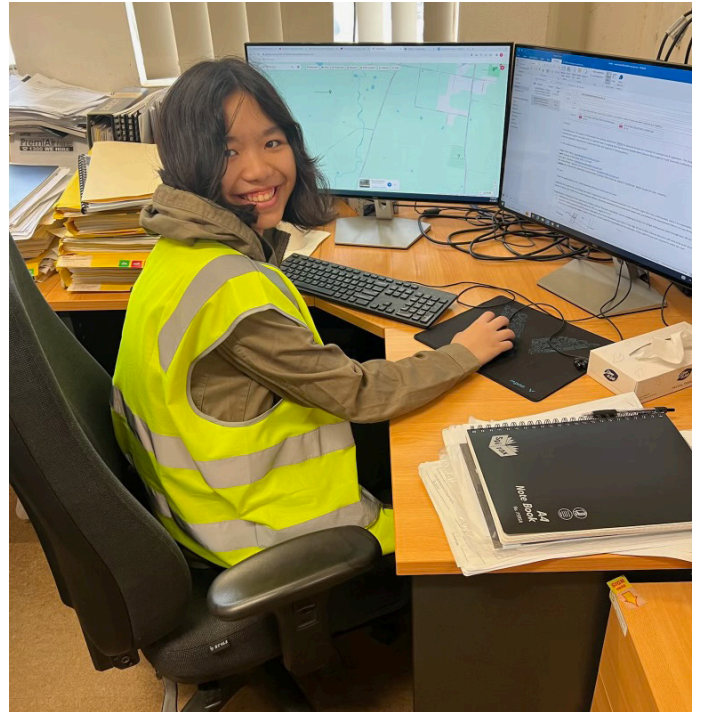




## Year 10 Work Experience

# WHAT STUDENTS NEED - 2024

## STUDENT REQUIREMENTS FOR LESSONS

Students are required to have the correct materials for each lesson. The basic items for all classroom lessons include:

**Students in all years should have a scientific calculator for use in mathematics classes. These are available for purchase at school at a considerably cheaper price. (ABACUS SX-II MATRIXn \$24.00).**

Students are not to bring liquid paper or permanent markers to school.
